Greetings,

Development and Peace/Caritas Canada, the official development organization of the Canadian Catholic Church, has not been exempt from the consequences of Covid19. Because there was no Share Lent collection in parishes during March, a \$5 million shortfall resulted. Commitments to partners were kept but no new projects have been accepted. Significant cutbacks and staff layoffs had to be made, e.g. Armella Sonntag, our public engagement officer for the West, and Louise Bitz, our Catholic Schools program officer. We are grateful to some parishioners who dropped off their envelopes at the parish office or donated virtually (\$500,000 was collected across Canada and \$500,000 for the Emergency collection for Beirut, Lebanon).

In Bishop Mark Hagemoen's appeal letter we read, "The status and treatment of the orphan, the stranger, the poor and marginalized – are now manifest in new ways as our diocese, country and world confronts new awareness of the history of how we treat brothers and sisters."

In response to D&P's request to hold a Recovery Collection this fall, Bishop Mark has responded with the following, "As a special Diocesan collection for Diocesan Mission work is taking place the weekend of November 15, 2020, fifty percent of the collection will be designated to Development Peace initiatives in response to COVID-19 around the globe."

Therefore we request that you make the Fall Campaign, **Recovering Together**, and this special collection known to your parishioners with whatever means are available to you. Promotion materials can be found at https://www.devp.org/en/education/fall2020/materials. No materials for the Fall Action campaign were mailed out this fall as you may have noticed.
